

# Adding Custom CSS to Concierge

If you want to customize the look and feel of the Concierge to align it with your brand, you can easily do so by adding custom CSS. This guide will walk you through the steps to add your custom styling using the v2 Concierge API.

## How to Add Custom CSS to Concierge

To add custom styling to the Concierge, follow these steps:

### 1. Navigate to Your Website's Code

- Identify the web page where you have integrated the Concierge.
- Ensure you have access to edit the JavaScript configuration for that page.
- Identify the CSS query selector of the component within the Concierge that you would like to customize.

### 2. Add the Configuration Code

- Utilize the `css` option in the Concierge configuration to define your custom CSS. Here is an example configuration:

- Adjust the CSS styles as needed to match your desired look and feel.
- Put the configuration code on top of the Concierge script tag

### 3. Implement and Test

- Save your changes and refresh the webpage to see your custom styles applied to the Concierge.
- Test thoroughly across different browsers and devices to ensure the styles render correctly.
