## **All Saints – University City, 1901-2023**

Located at 6403 Clemens Ave. All Saints was subsumed into Christ the King Parish in 2023. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact Christ the King Parish.

## **Annunciation - St. Louis City, 1861-1951**

Located at 6<sup>th</sup> and LaSalle. Building demolished in 1951.

## **Ascension – Normandy, 1945-1995**

Located at 7005 Ascension Drive. In 1995, Ascension and St. Paul (Pine Lawn) merged to form Ascension/St. Paul.

## **Ascension / St. Paul – Normandy, 1995-2008**

Located at 7005 Ascension Drive. In 1995, Ascension and St. Paul (Pine Lawn) merged to form Ascension/St. Paul, located at the church site of Ascension. In 2008, Ascension/St. Paul was suppressed. Its territory in St. Louis County was joined to St. Ann in Normandy. Its territory in St. Louis City was split between Our Lady of the Holy Cross and St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist.

## **Assumption – Herculaneum, 1916-2016**

Located at 329 Station St.

## **Assumption – Perryville, 1817-1965**

Located at 1000 Rosati Court. Building demolished. In 1965, Assumption merged with St. Boniface in Perryville to form St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Perryville. Contact St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Perryville for sacramental records.

## **Assumption - St. Louis City, 1861-1965**

Located at 917 Sidney St. Building demolished.

**Blessed Teresa of Calcutta – Ferguson, 2005-2023**

Located at 120 N. Elizabeth Ave. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish. In 2023, Blessed Teresa of Calcutta was subsumed into Sacred Heart Parish in Florissant. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact Sacred Heart Parish in Florissant.

**Corpus Christi – Jennings, 1915-2005**

Located at 8449 Jennings Road. In 1999, Corpus Christi took over the territories of St. Lucy and St. Louise de Marillac. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome.

**Cure of Ars – Shrewsbury, 1961-2023**

Located at 670 S. Laclede Station Rd. In 2023, Cure of Ars was subsumed into St. Michael the Archangel Parish in Shrewsbury. For sacraments that may have occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Michael the Archangel Parish in Shrewsbury.

**Good Shepherd – Ferguson, 1958-2005**

Located at 921 Smith Ave. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish.

**Holy Angels / Our Lady of the Angels – Kinloch, 1931-2002**

Located at 8122 Scott St. In 2002, Holy Angels was suppressed and its territory joined to that of St. Bartholomew Parish in Hazelwood. The Holy Angels property was donated to the City of Kinloch for a Museum and learning center, and the church was demolished.

**Holy Cross - St. Louis City, 1863-1993**

Formerly located in the town of Baden, which was incorporated into St. Louis City in 1876. Located at 8115-8145 Church Rd. In 1993, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Holy Cross merged to form Our Lady of the Holy Cross, located at the site of the former Holy Cross Parish.

**Holy Family – St. Louis City, 1898-2005**

Located at 4125 Humphrey Ave. In 2005, Holy Family Parish and School were suppressed, and its territory and school were united with St. John the Baptist Parish and School.

**Holy Ghost – Berkeley, 1923-1999**

Located at 6314 Garfield Ave. In 1999, Holy Ghost was suppressed and its territory joined to that of St. Bartholomew Parish in Hazelwood.

**Holy Ghost - St. Louis City, 1879-1962**

Located at 1901 N. Taylor Ave. Building demolished in 1975. In 1961, Visitation and Holy Ghost merged to form Visitation-Holy Ghost. The parish was renamed Visitation in 1975.

**Holy Guardian Angels - St. Louis City, 1866-1992**

Located at 1019 S. 14th St. In 1992, Holy Guardian Angels was suppressed and its territory joined to St. Vincent de Paul Parish.

**Holy Innocents - St. Louis City, 1854-2005**

Located at 4923 Odell St. In 2005, Holy Innocents Parish was suppressed. Its territory south of Arsenal Street was united to St. Mary Magdalen Parish, and its territory north of Arsenal Street was united to St. Ambrose Parish.

**Holy Trinity - St. Ann, 2002-2020**

Located at 3500 St. Luke Lane. In 2002, St. Gregory, St. Kevin, and St. William were merged to form Holy Trinity in St. Ann, located at the site of the former St. Gregory Parish.

**Immaculate Conception – Arnold, 1840-2023**

Located at 2300 Church Rd. In 2023, the parishes of Immaculate Conception and St. David merged to form Holy Family (named Feb 2024), located at the site of the former Immaculate Conception. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact Holy Family Parish in Arnold.

**Immaculate Conception – Maplewood, 1904-2023**

Located at 2934 Marshall Ave. In 2023, Immaculate Conception was subsumed into St. Mary Magdalen Parish in Brentwood. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Mary Magdalen Parish in Brentwood.

**Immaculate Conception - St. Mary, 1874-2018****Immaculate Conception - St. Louis City, 1854-1977**

Located at 3120 Lafayette Ave. In 1977, St. Henry merged with Immaculate Conception to form Immaculate Conception/St. Henry, which was located at the site of former Immaculate Conception Parish.

**Immaculate Conception / St. Henry - St. Louis City, 1977-2005**

Located at 3120 Lafayette Ave. In 1977, St. Henry merged with Immaculate Conception to form Immaculate Conception/St. Henry, located at the site of former Immaculate Conception Parish. In 2005, Immaculate Conception/St. Henry was suppressed and its territory united to St. Margaret of Scotland Parish.

**Immaculate Heart of Mary – St. Louis, 1951-2023**

Located at 4092 Blow St. In 2023, Immaculate Heart of Mary was subsumed into St. Stephen Protomartyr Parish. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Stephen Protomartyr Parish.

**Immaculate Conception - West Alton, 1924-2023****Mary, Queen of the Universe – Lemay, 1955-2003**

Located at 4230 Ripa Ave. In 2003, Mary Queen of the Universe Parish was suppressed and its territory joined to St. Mark in Affton. The church became the chapel for St. Mark School.

**Most Blessed Sacrament - St. Louis City, 1908-2000**

Located at 5017 Northland Ave. In 2000, Most Blessed Sacrament Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist.

**Most Holy Name of Jesus - St. Louis City, 1865-1992**

In 1987, a fire destroyed Our Lady of Perpetual Help Church and parishioners began attending Most Holy Name. The partnership was sometimes referred to as Our Lady of Perpetual Help/Most Holy Name. In 1992, Most Holy Name of Jesus was suppressed and its territory joined to that of Most Holy Trinity Parish.

**Most Holy Rosary - St. Louis City, 1891-1994**

Located at 2047 E. Grand Blvd. In 1994, St. Engelbert and Most Holy Rosary merged to form St. Elizabeth Mother of John the Baptist, located at the St. Engelbert location.

**Most Holy Trinity - St. Louis City, 1848-2023**

Located at 3519 N. 14th St. Formerly located in the town of Bremen, which was incorporated into St. Louis City in 1850. In 1991, St. Liborius merged with Most Holy Trinity to form Most Holy Trinity/St. Liborius, located at the site of Most Holy Trinity. In 1992, Our Lady of Perpetual Help/Most Holy Name and Most Holy Trinity/St. Liborius were suppressed and Most Holy Trinity took over their former territories. In 2023, the parishes of Most Holy Trinity, Saint Nicholas and Saints Teresa and Bridget were merged to form St. Josephine Bakhita, which is located at the site of the former St. Teresa Church at 2431 N. Grand Blvd.

**Most Holy Trinity (Slovak) - St. Louis City, 1898-1982**

Located at 1808 S. 9th St.

**Most Precious Blood - Lemay, 1961-2003**

Located at 3701 Union Rd., Lemay, MO. In 2003, Most Precious Blood was suppressed and its territory joined to that of St. Mark in Affton.

**Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary – Belgique, 1884-1992**

Located at 1200 W. Main, Box 66, Park Hills, MO. In 1992, Nativity of the Blessed Virgin Mary was suppressed and Our Lady of Victory Parish in Sereno took over the territory.

**Nativity of Our Lord - St. Louis City, 1904-1982**

Located at 5513 Oriole. In 1982, Nativity Parish was suppressed, and its territory was divided between St. Adalbert and St. Philip Neri Parishes.

**North American Martyrs – Florissant, 1955-2005**

Located at 1400 S. Lafayette St. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish. The territory north of Interstate 270 was joined to Sacred Heart Parish in Florissant.

**Notre Dame de Lourdes – Wellston, 1902-1992**

Located at 1701 Kienlen Ave. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish.

**Our Lady Help of Christians - St. Louis City, 1900-1975**

Located at 1010 Cole St. In 1975, Our Lady Help of Christians was suppressed. The church building demolished in 1975.

**Our Lady of Covandago - St. Louis City, 1915-1932**

Located at Virginia and Blow.

**Our Lady of Czestochowa - St. Louis City, 1906-1957**

Located at 4th and Victor. Building demolished in 1957.

**Our Lady of Fatima – Florissant, 1950-2005**

Located at 4500-50 Washington St. In 2005, St. Dismas, Our Lady of Fatima (territory north of Interstate 270), and St. Thomas the Apostle merged to form St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Parish, located at the site of the former St. Dismas Parish. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish.

**Our Lady of Good Counsel - Bellefontaine Neighbors, 1894-2005**

Located at 1100-1160 St. Cyr Rd. in Bellefontaine Neighbors. Parish was located at 1114 Destrehan in St. Louis City from 1894-1950. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome.

**Our Lady of Loretto - Spanish Lake, 1959-2005**

Located at 11725 Bellefontaine Rd. In 2005, Our Lady of Loretto, St. Aloysius, and Transfiguration territory east of Highway 367 merged to form Our Lady of the Rosary, at the site of the former Our Lady of Loretto Parish.

**Our Lady of Mercy – Hazelwood, 1964-2005**

Located at 1607 Villa Maura Lane. In 2005, Our Lady of Mercy Parish was suppressed and its membership and territory joined to St. Martin de Porres Parish.

**Our Lady of Mount Carmel - St. Louis City, 1871-1993**

Located at 8747 Annetta Ave. In 1993, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Holy Cross merged to form Our Lady of the Holy Cross, located at the site of the former Holy Cross Parish.

**Our Lady of Perpetual Help - St. Louis City, 1874-1992**

Located at 2011 Linten Ave. In 1987, a fire destroyed the church and parishioners began attending Most Holy Name. The merger was referred to as Our Lady of Perpetual Help/Most Holy Name. In 1992, Our Lady of Perpetual Help/Most Holy Name and Most Holy Trinity/St. Liborius were suppressed and Most Holy Trinity took over their former territories.

**Our Lady of Sorrows – St. Louis City, 1907-2023**

Located at 5020 Rhodes Ave. In 2023, Our Lady of Sorrows, St. Joan of Arc, and St. Mary Magdalen were merged to form St. Lucy at the site of former St. Joan of Arc.

**Our Lady of the Holy Cross – St. Louis City, 1993-2023**

Located at 8115 Church Road. In 1993, Our Lady of Mount Carmel and Holy Cross merged to form Our Lady of the Holy Cross, located at the site of the former Holy Cross Parish. In 2023, Our Lady of the Holy Cross, Saint Augustine, Saint Elizabeth Mother of John the Baptist, and Saint Matthew merged. On September 9, 2024, the merger was complete to form the new parish of St. Peter Claver at the site of former St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist.

**Our Lady of the Presentation – Overland, 1915-2023**

Located at 8860 Tudor Ave. In 2023, Our Lady of the Presentation was subsumed into St. Ann Parish in Normandy. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Ann Parish in Normandy.

**Our Lady of the Rosary – Claryville, 1874-1963****Our Lady of the Rosary - Spanish Lake, 2005-2016**

Located at 11725 Bellefontaine Rd. In 2005, Our Lady of Loretto, St. Aloysius, and Transfiguration territory east of Highway 367 merged to form Our Lady of the Rosary, at the site of the former Our Lady of Loretto Parish.

**Resurrection of Our Lord – St. Louis City, 1930-present**

Located at 3900 Meramec. In 2005, Resurrection of Our Lord was suppressed as a territorial parish and designated as a personal parish for the faithful of Vietnamese language and heritage, and its territory and school united to St. John the Baptist Parish and School. Contact Resurrection for sacramental records.

**Sacred Heart of Jesus - St. Louis City, 1871-1978**

Located at 23rd and University. In 1978, Sacred Heart of Jesus Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to that of St. Augustine Parish. The building was destroyed by fire in 1986.

**St. Adalbert – St. Louis City, 1912-1993**

Located at 5720 Woodland. In 1993, St. Philip Neri and St. Adalbert parishes merged to form Simon of Cyrene, located at the site of former St. Philip Neri.

**St. Agnes – St. Louis City, 1891-1993**

Located at 1933 Sidney St. In 1993, St. Agnes was suppressed and St. Francis de Sales took over the territory.

**St. Aloysius – Spanish Lake, 1908-2005**

Located at 1200-110 Larimore Rd. In 2005, Our Lady of Loretto, St. Aloysius, and Transfiguration territory east of Highway 367 merged to form Our Lady of the Rosary, at the site of the former Our Lady of Loretto Parish.

**St. Aloysius Gonzaga - St. Louis, 1892-2005**

Located at 5608 N. Magnolia Ave. In 2005, St. Aloysius Gonzaga was suppressed and its territory united to St. Ambrose Parish. The buildings were demolished in 2006.

**St. Andrew – Lemay, 1905-2023**

Located at 309 Hoffmeister Ave. In 2023, St. Andrew was subsumed into St. Mark Parish in Lemay. For sacraments that occurred at this church on July 31, 2023, or prior, please contact the Archdiocese of Saint Louis Archives. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Mark Parish in Lemay.

**St. Ann Parish & Shrine - St. Louis City, 1897-1992**

Located at 1220 Whittier St. Parish was named Saint Paul from 1891-1897. In 1897 the name was changed to Saint Ann. In 1992, St. Ann merged with Visitation/Holy Ghost to form Visitation-St. Ann Parish, located at the site of former Visitation Parish. Visitation-St. Ann was suppressed in 2016.

**St. Augustine - St. Louis City, 1874-1982**

Located at 3114 Linsmore. (German) In 1982, St. Augustine Parish was suppressed and its territory divided among the parishes of St. Liborius, St. Bridget of Erin, and Most Holy Trinity.

**St. Augustine – St. Louis City, 1992-2023**

Located at 1371 Hamilton Ave. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish. In 2023, Our Lady of the Holy Cross, Saint Augustine, Saint Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist, and Saint Matthew merged. On September 9, 2024, the merger was complete to form the new parish of St. Peter Claver at the site of former St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist.

**St. Barbara - St. Louis City, 1893-1992**

Located at 1371 Hamilton Ave. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish.

**St. Barnabas the Apostle – O’Fallon, 1961-2023**

Located at 1400 N. Main St. In 2023, St. Barnabas was subsumed into Assumption Parish in O’Fallon. The St. Barnabas sacramental records are located at the Archdiocesan Archives. In 2023, St. Juan Diego was newly erected personal parish and located at the site of former St. Barnabas.

**St. Bartholomew – Hazelwood, 1959-2005**

Located at 8370 Latty Ave. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish.

**St. Bernadette – Lemay, 1947-2023**

Located at 68 Sherman Rd. In 2023, St. Bernadette was subsumed into St. Mark Parish in Lemay.

**St. Bernard - St. Louis City, 1874-1973**

Located at 4019 Gratiot Rd. In 1973, St. Bernard Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to St. Cronan. The church building was demolished for highway construction.

**St. Blaise - St. Louis City, 1961-2004**

Located at 3130 Parkwood Land. In 2004, St. Blaise and St. Lawrence (Bridgeton) merged to form Holy Spirit Parish, located at the site of former St. Blaise Parish.

**St. Bonaventure - St. Louis City, 1871-1883**

Located at 6th and Spruce. Building was demolished.

**St. Boniface – Perryville, 1869-1964**

Building was demolished. In 1965, Assumption merged with St. Boniface in Perryville to form St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Perryville. For sacramental records, contact St. Vincent de Paul Parish in Perryville.

**St. Boniface - St. Louis City, 1860-2005**

Located at 7622 Michigan Ave. In 2005, St. Boniface Parish was suppressed, and its territory united to St. Stephen Protomartyr Parish.

**St. Bridget of Erin – St. Louis City, 1853-2003**

Located at 2401 Carr St. In 2003, St. Bridget of Erin and St. Teresa of Avila merged to form Sts. Teresa and Bridget, opening at the St. Teresa location.

**St. Casimir - Hathaway Manor, 1889-1992**

Located at 10725 Vorhof Dr. St. Casimir was formerly located in St. Louis City at 8<sup>th</sup> and Mullanphy from 1889-1955, and the building was demolished for highway construction. In 1992, St. Casimir was suppressed, and St. Christopher took over the territory.

**St. Catherine of Alexandria –Ste. Genevieve / Coffman, 1887-2023**

Located at 23496 State Route WW, Ste. Genevieve, MO. In 2023, St. Catherine of Alexandria was subsumed into St. Joseph Parish in Farmington.

**St. Catherine of Alexandria – Riverview, 1921-2005**

Located at 351 Chambers Rd., Riverview Gardens, MO. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome.

**St. Catherine of Siena – Pagedale, 1921-2005**

Located at 6815-6900 Page Ave.

**St. Charles Borromeo - St. Louis City, 1903-1982**

Located at 29th and Locust. In 1982, St. Charles Borromeo was suppressed. The buildings were demolished.

**St. Christopher – Florissant, 1967-2005**

Located at 11575 Old Halls Ferry Rd. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome. The territory north of Highway I-270 was joined with St. Angela Merici Parish in Florissant.

**St. Columbkille – Byrnesville, 1880-1957**

Located at 4696 Notre Dame Lane. St. Columbkille-Byrnesville and St. Philomena-House Springs sacramental records from 1880 to 1961 are together in the St. Columbkille registers.

**St. Columbkille - St. Louis City, 1872-1952**

Located at 8200 Michigan Ave.

**St. Cronan Parish - St. Louis City, 1878-2023, Church 2023-present**

Located at 1203 S. Boyle Ave. In 2005, St. Cronan was designated a personal parish dedicated to the apostolate of social justice, and its territory was united to St. Margaret of Scotland. In 2023, St. Cronan was suppressed as a parish, and its status changed to "Church." St. Margaret of Scotland took over the territory formerly overseen by St. Cronan. The St. Cronan sacramental registers are in the Archdiocesan Archives. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Margaret of Scotland.

**St. David – Arnold, 1963-2023**

Located at 2334 Tenbrook Rd. In 2023, the parishes of Immaculate Conception and St. David merged to form Holy Family (named Feb 2024), located at the site of the former Immaculate Conception. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact Holy Family Parish.

**St. Dismas – Florissant, 1957-2005**

Located at 2651 Parker Rd. In 2005, St. Dismas, Our Lady of Fatima (territory north of Interstate 270), and St. Thomas the Apostle merged to form St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Parish, located at the site of the former St. Dismas Parish.

**St. Dominic Savio – Affton, 1956-2018**

Located at 6120 Pebble Hill Dr. In 2018, St. George and St. Dominic Savio merged to form St. John Paul II Parish, located at the site of the former St. George Parish.

**St. Edward - St. Louis City, 1893-1992**

Located at 2709 Clara Ave. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish.

**St. Elizabeth - St. Louis City, 1873-1951**

Located at 2731 Pine St. The parish was suppressed by Cardinal Ritter to encourage racial integration.

**St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist – St. Louis, 1994-2023**

Located at 4330 Shreve Ave. In 1994, St. Engelbert and Most Holy Rosary merged to form St. Elizabeth Mother of John the Baptist, located at the site of former St. Engelbert Parish. In 2000, St. Elizabeth took over the territory of Most Blessed Sacrament. In 2023, Our Lady of the Holy Cross, Saint Augustine, Saint Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist, and Saint Matthew merged. **St. Frances Xavier Cabrini – Jennings, 1965-1999**

Located at 8450 Lucas and Hunt Rd.

**St. Francis of Assisi – Luebbering, 1874-2023**

Located at 1000 Luebbering Rd. In 2023, St. Francis of Assisi was subsumed into St. Clare Parish in St. Clair.

**St. Francis of Assisi – Portage De Sioux, 1799-2023**

Located at 1355 Farnham St. In 2023, St. Francis of Assisi was subsumed into St. Charles Borromeo Parish in St. Charles. For sacraments that occurred at this church since August 1, 2023, please contact St. Charles Borromeo Parish.

**St. Francis De Sales - St. Louis City, 1867-2005, Oratory 2005-present**

Located at 2653 Ohio Ave. In 1993, St. Agnes was suppressed and St. Francis de Sales took over the territory. In 2005, St. Francis de Sales was suppressed as a parish and opened as an oratory run by the Institute of Christ the King Sovereign Priest. The Archdiocesan Archives holds the sacramental registers up to 2005. Contact St. Francis de Sales for sacraments that occurred after 2005.

**St. George – Affton, 1915-2018**

Located at 4980 Heege Rd. In 2018, St. George and St. Dominic Savio merged to form St. John Paul II Parish, located at the site of the former St. George Parish.

**St. Gregory - St. Ann, 1942-2002**

Located at 3500 Saint Luke Lane. In 2002, St. Gregory, St. Kevin, and St. William were merged to form Holy Trinity in St. Ann, located at the site of the former St. Gregory Parish.

**St. Hedwig - St. Louis City, 1904-2005**

Located at 3202 Pulaski St. In 2005, St. Hedwig Parish was suppressed, and its territory united to St. Anthony of Padua Parish.

**St. Henry - St. Louis City, 1885-1977**

Located at California and Hickory. In 1977, St. Henry merged with Immaculate Conception to form Immaculate Conception/St. Henry.

**St. Jerome - Bellefontaine Neighbors, 1952-2005**

Located at 10235 Ashbrook Dr. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome.

**St. Joan of Arc – St. Louis City, 1941-2023**

Located at 5800 Oleatha Ave. In 2023, Our Lady of Sorrows, St. Joan of Arc, and St. Mary Magdalen were merged to form St. Lucy, at the site of former St. Joan of Arc.

**Sts. John and James – Ferguson, 1882-2005**

Located at 120 N. Elizabeth Ave. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish.

**St. John Bosco – Maryland Heights, 1972-2023**

Located at 12934 Marine Ave. In 2023, St. John Bosco was subsumed into St. Monica Parish in Creve Coeur.

**St. John Nepomuk Parish - St. Louis City, 1854-2005, Chapel 2005-present**

Located at 1625 S. 11th St. St. John Nepomuk was suppressed as a parish in 2005 and opened as a chapel. Contact St. John Nepomuk to obtain your baptismal or marriage certificate. The Archdiocesan Archives holds the registers for baptism from 1854-1927; marriage 1854-1944; death 1865-2010; first communion 1927-2006; and confirmation 1926-1996. Records at the archives are not open to public research. **St. John Paul II – Affton, 2018-2023**

Located at 4980 Heege Rd. In 2018, St. George and St. Dominic Savio merged to form St. John Paul II Parish, located at the site of the former St. George Parish. In 2023, St. John Paul II was subsumed into Seven Holy Founders Parish in Affton.

**St. John the Apostle and Evangelist Pro-cathedral – St. Louis City, 1847-2023**

Located at 15 Plaza Square. In 2005, St. John the Apostle and Evangelist was designated the territorial parish of downtown, and the territory of the Basilica of St. Louis, King of France, which was designated a personal parish, was joined to St. John's. In 2023, the Basilica of St. Louis, King of France was designated a personal and territorial parish, and St. John the Apostle and Evangelist was subsumed by the Basilica.

**St. John the Apostle Mission – Bismarck, 1879-2023**

In 2023, St. John the Apostle Mission was subsumed into Immaculate Conception Parish in Park Hills.

**St. John the Baptist – St. Louis, 1914-2023**

Located at 4200 Delor St. In 2005, St. John the Baptist took over the territories of Resurrection of Our Lord and Holy Family Parishes. In 2023, St. John the Baptist was subsumed into St. Stephen Protomartyr Parish.

**St. John the Evangelist – Lithium, 1904-1985**

Located at Route 4, Box 347, Perryville, MO (Lithium) 63775. Archives does not hold the sacramental registers for St. John the Evangelist. To request a sacramental record, please contact St. Vincent de Paul parish in Perryville.

**St. Joseph - St. Louis City, 1844-1982; Shrine of St. Joseph, 1982-present**

Located at 2112 S. 12th St., or 11<sup>th</sup> and Bidle. On July 9, 1982, Archbishop John May suppressed St. Joseph as a parish and canonically declared it a Shrine. The Archdiocesan Archives holds the sacramental registers up to 1978 for baptisms and 1979 for marriages. Sacraments between 1978/1979 and 1981 were recorded at St. Patrick's Convention Center Parish, which are also held at the Archives. Contact St. Joseph Shrine for sacraments dated 1981 and later.

**St. Joseph – Tiff, 1905-2023**

Located at C/O 10120 Crest Rd. in Cadet, MO. In 2023, St. Joseph was subsumed into St. Joachim Parish in Old Mines.

**St Joseph National Lithuanian - St. Louis City, 1915-1970**

Located at Park and Anderson.

**St. Jude – Overland, 1953-2023**

Located at 2218 N. Warson Rd. In 2023, St. Jude was subsumed into Holy Spirit Parish in Maryland Heights.

**St. Kevin - St. Ann, 1953-2002**

Located at 2100-2123 Park Ave. In 2002, St. Gregory, St. Kevin, and St. William were merged to form Holy Trinity in St. Ann, located at the site of the former St. Gregory Parish.

**St. Kevin - St. Louis City, 1876-1908**

Located at Park and Cardinal. Merged with Immaculate Conception at Lafayette and Longfellow in 1908.

**St. Lawrence – Lawrenceton, 1872-2023**

Located at C/O 40 St. Agnes Dr. in Bloomsdale. *In 2023, St. Lawrence was subsumed into St. Agnes Parish in Bloomsdale. The appeal is currently under review.* For sacramental records, please contact St. Lawrence in Lawrenceton.

**St. Lawrence O'Toole - St. Louis City, 1855-1948**

Located at 14th and O'Fallon. Building was demolished.

**St. Lawrence the Martyr – Bridgeton, 1960-2004**

Located at 4329-4335 DuPage Dr. Building was demolished. In 2004, St. Blaise and St. Lawrence (Bridgeton) merged to form Holy Spirit Parish, located at the site of former St. Blaise Parish.

**St. Leo - St. Louis City, 1888-1978**

Located at 2315 Mullanphy St. In 1978, St. Leo was suppressed, and its territory joined to that of St. Bridget of Erin. The building was demolished.

**St. Liborius - St. Louis City, 1856-1992**

Located at 1825 N. 18th St. In 1991, St. Liborius merged with Most Holy Trinity to form Most Holy Trinity/St. Liborius, located at the site of Most Holy Trinity. In 1992, Our Lady of Perpetual Help/Most Holy Name and Most Holy Trinity/St. Liborius were suppressed, and Most Holy Trinity took over their former territories.

**St. Louise de Marillac – Jennings, 1935-1999**

Located at 6350 Garesch Ave. In 1999, St. Louise de Marillac Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to Corpus Christi Parish.

**St. Lucy – Jennings, 1957-1999**

Located at 2559 Dorwood Dr. In 1992, the pastor at Corpus Christi began administering the parish of St. Lucy. In 1999, St. Lucy Parish was suppressed, and Corpus Christi took over its territory.

**St. Luke the Evangelist - Richmond Heights, 1914-2023**

Located at 7230 Dale Ave. In 2023, St. Luke was subsumed into Our Lady of Lourdes in University City.

**St. Malachy - St. Louis City, 1858-1959**

Located at 2904 Clark Ave. Building was demolished.

**St. Mark - St. Louis City, 1893-1992**

Located at Page and Academy. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish.

**St. Martin de Porres – Hazelwood, 1962-2023**

Located at 615 Dunn Rd. In 2023, St. Martin de Porres was subsumed into St. Ferdinand Parish in Florissant.

**St. Mary's – Bridgeton, 1851-2001**

Located at 4603 Long Road. In 2001, St. Mary was suppressed, and its territory was divided among St. Blaise, St. Kevin, St. Lawrence, and St. Gregory. The building was demolished.

**Sts. Mary and Joseph Parish - St. Louis City, Parish 1821-2005, Chapel 2005-2022**

Located at 5304-6304 Minnesota Ave. In 2005, Sts. Mary and Joseph was suppressed as a parish and opened as a chapel for occasional Mass and devotions. St. Stephen Protomartyr absorbed its territory and assumed responsibility for the chapel. The chapel closed in 2022.

**St. Mary of Victories Parish - St. Louis City, 1860-2005, Chapel 2005-present**

Located at 744 S. 3rd St. In 2005, St. Mary of Victories was suppressed as a parish and opened as a chapel in which Mass and devotions could be celebrated on special occasions. The Archdiocesan Archives holds sacramental registers up to 1959. Contact St. Mary of Victories for sacraments recorded after 1959.

**St. Mary Magdalen (Church of the Magdalen) – St. Louis City, 1919-2023**

Located at 4924 Bancroft Ave. In 2005, St. Mary Magdalen took over the territory of Holy Innocents Parish south of Arsenal Street. In 2023, Our Lady of Sorrows, St. Joan of Arc, and St. Mary Magdalen were merged to form St. Lucy, at the site of former St. Joan of Arc.

**St. Matthew the Apostle – St. Louis City, 1893-2023**

Last location at 2715 N. Sarah St. In 2023, Our Lady of the Holy Cross, Saint Augustine, Saint Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist, and Saint Matthew merged. On September 9, 2024, the merger was complete to form the new parish of St. Peter Claver at the site of former St. Elizabeth, Mother of John the Baptist.

**St. Matthias – Lemay, 1959-2023**

Located at 796 Buckley Rd. In 2023, St. Matthias was subsumed into St. Mark Parish in Lemay.

**St. Michael - St. Louis City, 1849-1975**

Located at 2101 N. 11th St. In 1975, St. Michael Parish was suppressed.

**St. Nicholas – St. Louis City, 1865-2023**

Located at 701 N. 18th St. In 2012, St. Nicholas took over the territory of St. Patrick Parish (Convention Center). In 2023, the parishes of Most Holy Trinity, Saint Nicholas and Saints Teresa and Bridget were merged to form St. Josephine Bakhita, which is located at the site of the former St. Teresa Church at 2431 N. Grand Blvd.

**St. Patrick - St. Louis City, 1842-1973**

Located at 6th and Biddle. Building was demolished.

**St. Patrick - St. Louis City Convention Center, 1981-2012**

Located at 1000 N. 7th St. In 2012, St. Patrick Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to that of St. Nicholas Parish.

**St. Patrick - University City, 1940-2001**

Located at 8865 Olive Blvd. The parish closed in 2001. St. Andrew Kim Parish was formed in 2001 and occupied the site of former St. Patrick Parish.

**St. Paul – Berger, 1858-2023**

Located at C/O 603 Miller St. in New Haven. In 2023, St. Paul was assumed into Assumption Parish in New Haven.

**St. Paul - St. Louis City, 1891-1897**

Became St. Ann Parish.

**St. Paul the Apostle - Pine Lawn, 1909-1995**

Located at 4001 Jennings Rd. In 1995, Ascension and St. Paul (Pine Lawn) merged to form Ascension/St. Paul, located at the church site of Ascension.

**Sts. Peter and Paul Parish – St. Louis, 1849-2023, Church 2023-present**

Located at 1919 S. Seventh St. In 2005, Sts. Peter and Paul was designated a personal parish dedicated to the apostolate on behalf of the homeless and to the promotion of sacred music through the Young Catholic Musicians, and its territory was joined to St. Vincent de Paul Parish. In 2023, Sts. Peter and Paul was suppressed as a personal parish and designated as a Church. St. Vincent de Paul took over the territory formerly overseen by Sts. Peter and Paul. The Archdiocesan Archives currently hold the historic sacramental registers of Sts. Peter and Paul, including baptism (1849-1925), first communion (1850-1879), confirmation (1850-1940), marriage (1849-1936), and burial (1941-1955). For sacramental records after these dates, please contact Sts. Peter and Paul.

**St. Peter Claver – Kinloch, 1916-1956**

Located on Fairview Ave.

**Sts. Philip and James – River Aux Vases, 1840-2023**

Located at 18411 RAV Church Rd. In 2023, Sts. Philip and James was subsumed into Ste. Genevieve Parish in Ste. Genevieve. For sacramental records, please contact Ste. Genevieve Parish in Ste. Genevieve.

**St. Philip Neri - St. Louis City, 1919-1993**

Located at 5076 Durant Ave. In 1993, St. Philip Neri and St. Adalbert parishes merged to form Simon of Cyrene, located at the site of former St. Philip Neri.

**St. Pius X - Glasgow Village, 1954-2005**

Located at 235-335 Shepley Dr. In 2005, Corpus Christi, St. Pius X, Our Lady of Good Counsel, and St. Catherine of Alexandria, St. Jerome, and St. Christopher's territory south of Highway I-270, merged to form Holy Name of Jesus Parish, located at the site of former St. Jerome.

**St. Rita – Vinita Park, 1914-2023**

Located at 8240 Washington St. In 2023, St. Rita was subsumed into Christ the King Parish in University City.

**St. Robert Bellarmine – St. Charles, 1963-2023**

Located at 1424 S. First Capitol Dr. In 2023, St. Robert Bellarmine was subsumed into St. Elizabeth Ann Seton Parish in St. Charles.

**St. Roch – St. Louis – 1911-2023**

Located at 6052 Waterman Blvd. In 2023, St. Roch was subsumed into Christ the King Parish in University City.

**St. Rose of Lima - St. Louis City, 1884-1992**

Located at 1015 Goodfellow. In 1992, Notre Dame de Lourdes, St. Barbara, St. Edward, St. Mark, and St. Rose merged to form St. Augustine Parish, located at the site of former St. Barbara Parish.

**St. Rose Philippine Duchesne – Florissant, 2005-2023**

Located at 1210 Paddock Dr. In 2005, St. Dismas, Our Lady of Fatima (territory north of Interstate 270), and St. Thomas the Apostle merged to form St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Parish, located at the site of the former St. Dismas Parish. In 2023, St. Rose Philippine Duchesne was subsumed into Sacred Heart Parish in Florissant.

**St. Sabina – Florissant, 1960-2023**

Located at 1365 Harkee Dr. In 2023, St. Sabina was subsumed into St. Ferdinand in Florissant.

**St. Sebastian – Glen Owen/Jennings, 1953-2005**

Located at 9950 Glen Owen Dr., Jennings, MO 63136. In 2005, Good Shepherd, Sts. John and James, St. Bartholomew, St. Sebastian, Our Lady of Fatima (territory south of Interstate 270), and North American Martyrs (territory south of Interstate 270) merged to form Blessed Teresa of Calcutta, located at the site of former Sts. John and James Parish.

**St. Simon of Cyrene - St. Louis City, 1993-2005**

Located at 5067 Durant Ave. In 1993, St. Philip Neri and St. Adalbert parishes merged to form St. Simon of Cyrene, located at the site of former St. Philip Neri. The Parish was suppressed in 2005.

**St. Stanislaus Kostka – St. Louis City, 1880-2005**

Located at 1413 N. 20<sup>th</sup>. Due to a schism in 2005, the parish was canonically suppressed and is not affiliated with the Roman Catholic Church.

**St. Stephen - Richwoods, 1841-2023**

Located at 11514 Highway A. In 2023, St. Stephen was subsumed into St. Joachim Parish in Old Mines.

**St. Stephen of Hungary - St. Louis City, 1934-1957**

Located at 1041 Chouteau Ave.

**St. Teresa of Avila - St. Louis City, 1885-2003**

Located at 3636 N. Market / 2431 N. Grand Blvd. In 2003, St. Bridget of Erin and St. Teresa of Avila merged to form Sts. Teresa and Bridget, opening at the St. Teresa location.

**Sts. Teresa and Bridget - St. Louis City, 2003-2023**

Located at 2431 N. Grand Blvd. In 2003, St. Bridget of Erin and St. Teresa of Avila merged to form Sts. Teresa and Bridget, opening at the St. Teresa location. In 2023, the parishes of Most

Holy Trinity, Saint Nicholas and Saints Teresa and Bridget were merged to form St. Josephine Bakhita, which is located at the site of the former St. Teresa Church at 2431 N. Grand Blvd.

**St. Thomas More - Bel Ridge, 1957-1999**

Located at 3425 Saint Thomas More Pl. In 1999, St. Thomas More Parish was suppressed, and its territory divided among the parishes of St. Ann in Normandy and Our Lady of the Presentation in Overland.

**St. Thomas of Aquin - St. Louis City, 1882-present**

Located at 3949 Iowa St. In 2005, St. Thomas of Aquin Parish was designated a personal parish for the faithful of Vietnamese language and heritage, and its former territory joined to St. Anthony of Padua Parish. The sacramental registers of St. Thomas of Aquin from 1882 to 2005 are located at the Archdiocesan Archives. Contact St. Thomas of Aquin Parish for sacramental records dated after 2005.

**St. Thomas the Apostle – Florissant, 1960-2005**

Located at 3500 Saint Catherine St. In 2005, St. Dismas, Our Lady of Fatima (territory north of Interstate 270), and St. Thomas the Apostle merged to form St. Rose Philippine Duchesne Parish, located at the site of the former St. Dismas Parish.

**St. Timothy - Affton, 1958-2003**

Located at 816-824 Union Rd., Affton, MO. In 2003, St. Timothy Parish was suppressed, and its territory joined to that of St. Mark in Affton.

**St. William - Woodson Terrace, 1953-2002**

Located at 9300-9311 Stansberry Ave. In 2002, St. Gregory, St. Kevin, and St. William were merged to form Holy Trinity in St. Ann, located at the site of the former St. Gregory Parish.

**Transfiguration – Florissant, 1965-2005**

Located at 6685-6855 Lakeside Hills. In 2005, Our Lady of Loretto, St. Aloysius, and Transfiguration territory east of Highway 367 merged to form Our Lady of the Rosary, at the site of the former Our Lady of Loretto Parish. Transfiguration's territory west of Highway 367 was joined to St. Angela Merici Parish in Florissant.

**Visitation/St. Ann - St. Louis City, 1881-2016**

Located at 4515 Evans Ave. Visitation parish was founded in 1881. In 1961, it merged with Holy Ghost to form Visitation-Holy Ghost. In 1975, it was renamed "Visitation." In 1992, it merged with St. Ann Parish & Shrine to form Visitation/St. Ann Shrine, located at the former site of Visitation Parish. It closed in 2016.

**Washington University Catholic Student Center - Open**

The Archdiocese of Saint Louis Archives acquired the sacramental records of Washington University Catholic Student Center, dated 1991-2024. For sacramental records before 1991 or after 2024, please contact Our Lady of Lourdes in University City.
