- 1. **REGISTRATION DEADLINE** The official #iGC registration deadline is November 1st. If you have not already done so, register today!
- 2. **ADVANCED GIVING-** The platform will open for donations on November 17th! Think of the next few weeks as a ramp up to build excitement around your campaign!
- 3. MATCHES As we have mentioned in the past few weeks, now is the time to solicit your match donors and set up your matches! If you need help setting up your match, check out THIS support article from Mightycause!
