Pope Leo appoints Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski to Interreligious Dicastery

Today, the Vatican informed Mitchell T. Rozanski, Archbishop of St. Louis, that he has been appointed by Pope Leo XIV to the Dicastery for Interreligious Dialogue.
