

In retirement, Priests' Mutual Benefit Society (PMBS) members may need various levels of assistance. The following information outlines levels of assistance and eligibility for retirement and housing allowances for each:

St. Agnes Priest Wing with Supportive Services	No	No
Approved Assisted Living Centers	No	No
Approved Long Term Skilled Nursing Facilities	No	No

Retirement and housing allowances are not impacted by short periods of recuperation or rehabilitation in a facility.

PMBS does not pay fees to archdiocesan facilities if a retired priest is in residence. The only housing assistance provided to retirees, who elect to live independently, is the PMBS housing allowance.

A retiree, who is receiving a retirement and/or a housing allowance and then moves to a facility which does not qualify for the payment(s), will be notified of the effective date of the change and the stoppage of the payment(s) by the PMBS office.
