Archbishop Rozanski to Celebrate Red Mass for Legal Professionals and Civic Officials

ST. LOUIS – Most Reverend Mitchell T. Rozanski, Archbishop of St. Louis, will celebrate the annual Red Mass on Sunday, October 3 for legal workers at the Cathedra Basilica of Saint Louis.

WHAT:

Judges, prosecutors, attorneys, law school professors and students and government officials are invited to join Archbishop Mitchell T. Rozanski as he celebrates the Red Mass honoring those who are servants of justice. The Red Mass was established in France in the 1300s by King Louis IX, the archdiocesan patron saint, and is a longstanding tradition. Following Mass, all attendees will be invited to a reception in the garden, which will adhere to COVID-19 safety guidelines.
