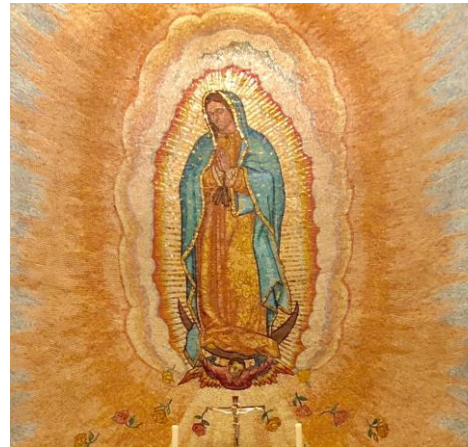

Starting Monday evening, December 8 into December 9, Archdiocese of St. Louis parishes will be praying for our "*nation to renew its commitment to live the Gospel of Life.*" Dates, times, and prayer format vary per church.



Originating in the Diocese of Rockville Centre, New York in 1989, what started out as a local parish prayer initiative has now grown into a coast-to-coast event involving 700-plus parishes, Knights of Columbus chapters and other pro-life and Catholic organizations.
