On Sunday, November 3, Archbishop Mitchell Rozanski will lead the Archdiocese of St. Louis into an intentional time of prayer for the defeat of the Missouri Pro-Abortion Amendment 3. The Archbishop will celebrate a special noon Mass at the Cathedral Basilica of St. Louis followed by a Holy Hour. That same day, 28 parishes and other Christian churches at 13 locations throughout the Archdiocese will join



in peaceful public witness and prayer with Amendment 3 Life Chains.
