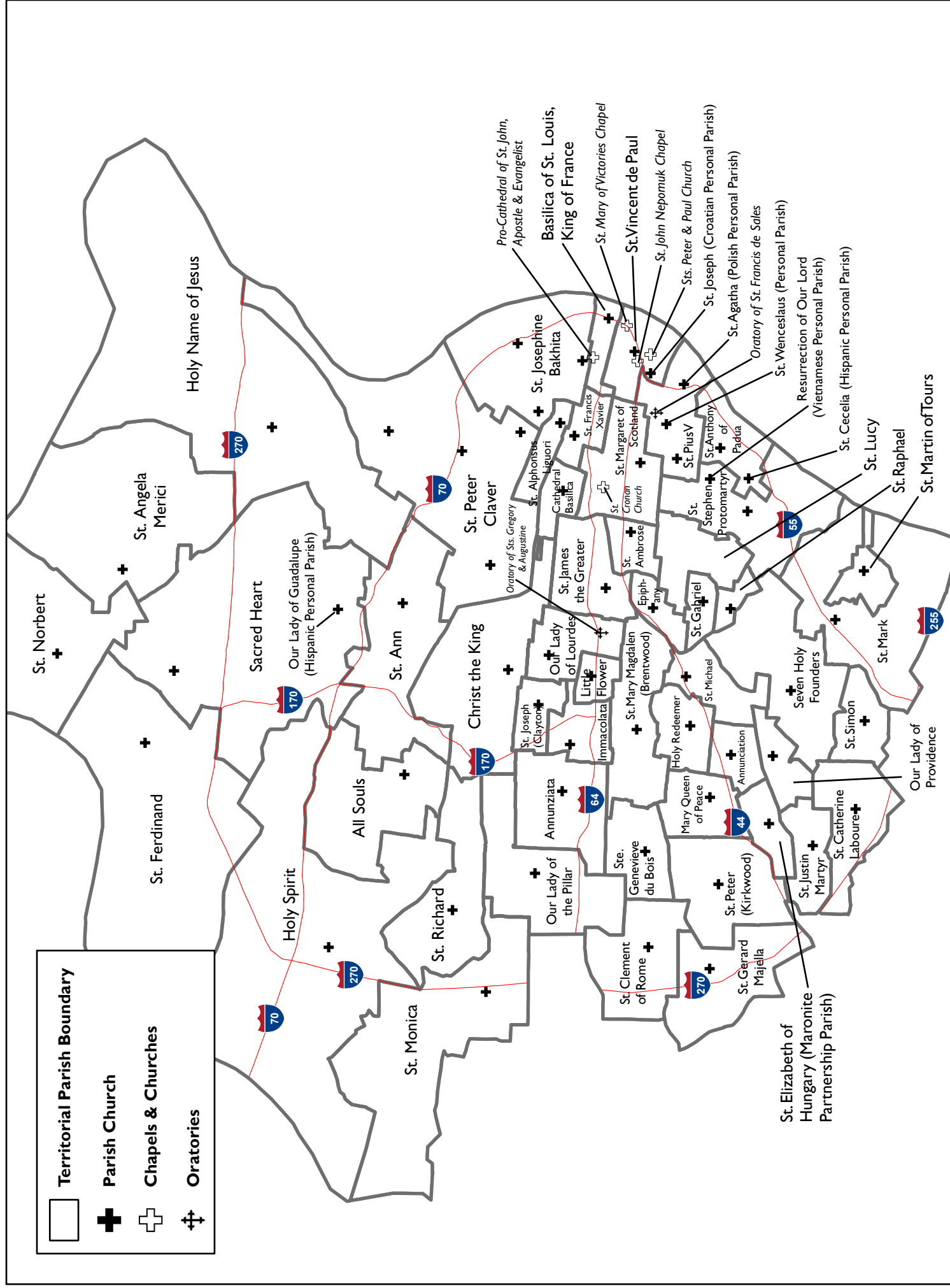

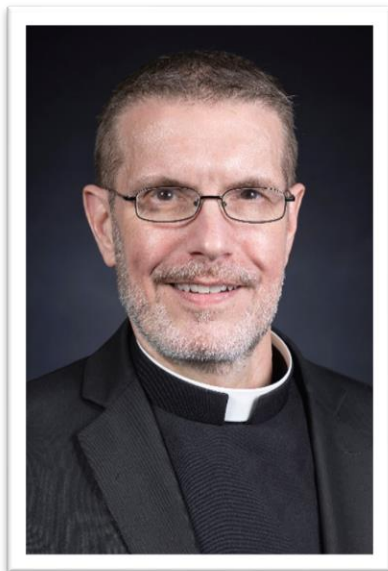

Since 1973, the Respect Life Apostolate (RLA) of the Archdiocese of St. Louis, the first diocesan office established in the U.S. devoted to the pro-life cause, cherishes preborn life, walks with pregnant and parenting mothers, and helps those wounded by abortion to heal. The RLA accomplishes this through spiritual, pastoral (direct care), educational, and public advocacy efforts. The apostolate lives out the Catholic Church's teachings on respect for and legal protection of every human life from conception through natural death, with a particular focus on the most vulnerable. The RLA promotes this mission of life among the over 400,000 Catholics, 135 parishes, 93 elementary schools, and 25 high schools which comprise the Archdiocese.

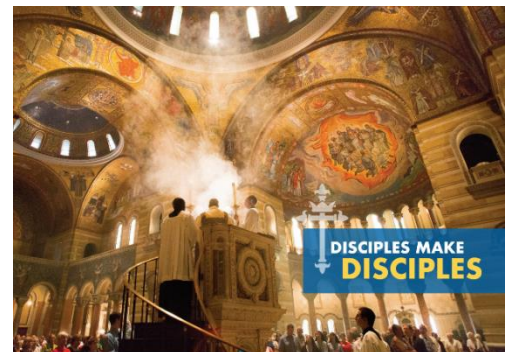

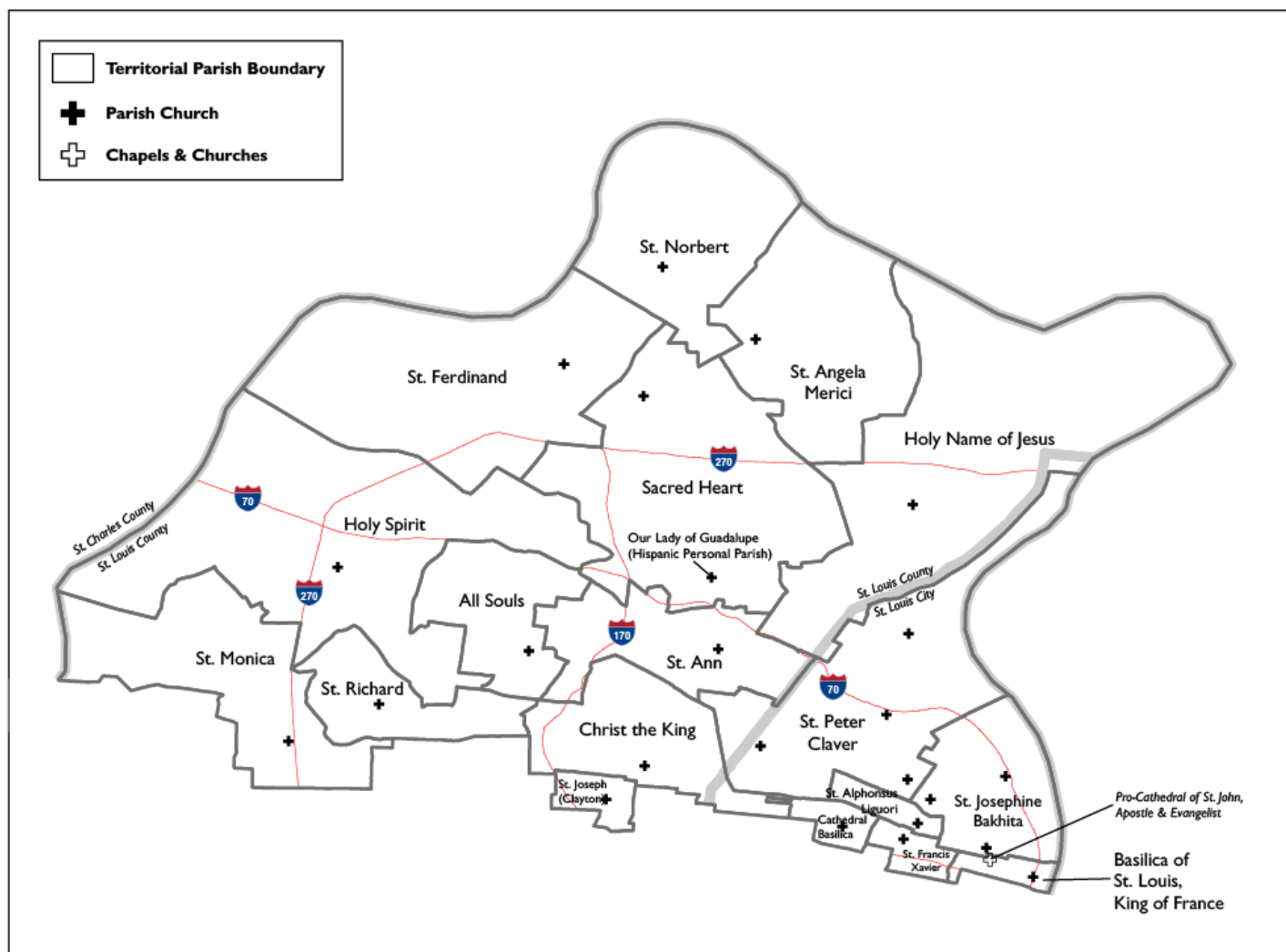
