### **Historical Note**

In 1931, the St. Louis Preparatory Seminary was revised to accommodate the third year of high school through two years of philosophy. The first two years of high school were assigned to the Cathedral Latin School, which opened in the renovated building at 4244 Washington Blvd. In 1947, the Preparatory Seminary again reformed to incorporate the first two years of high school and the Cathedral Latin School was closed.
