

Kenrick Day Book 1855-1858
FNCL/2112

Archbishop Peter Richard Kenrick maintained this day book receipts and expenses for the house and church from November 1855 through February 1858. Examples of expenses include wages to housekeepers, repairs, taxes, and food purchases. The book appears to have originally been used to record lots and expenses at Holy Trinity Cemetery from 1851-1852, but was repurposed for the day book use years later. Below is an index of the contents.
