(If you are a school or other ministry with a connection to a Catholic parish, ask them to include your messaging in their bulletins and announcements!) Here is a sample template:

- NOTE: QR codes are a fantastic tool on PRINTED items (and can be created for free using a variety of
 programs including Canva) but should not be included on any digital items that someone may see on
 their phone. If you're looking at it on your phone, you can't scan it with your phone! For digital
 communications, stick with hyperlinks.
