Minor Updates

- Users can now preview the resulting Schedule Line Record field values before saving a modification, giving them full visibility into the impact of a change prior to committing it.

Bug Fixes

- Alert the user when they don't have permission to process fees on leases when accessing the invoicing or adhoc fees pages.
- Fixed a bug where a true-up modification would generate an incorrect incremental transaction amount. The net back-billing activity was being double-counted — once on the modification schedule line and again on the credit memo — resulting in an overstated credit. The incremental transaction now correctly reflects only the per-period invoice delta. Also switched incremental transaction to use the same buildBill function as standard invoices.
- Fixed a bug where journal entry transaction date would not respect the global configuration posting date preferences if the custom calendar global setting was enabled.
- Fixed a bug where importing modifications via CSV with a remaining term value would result in the remaining term being overwritten with an incorrect calculated value. The new lease term and end date are now correctly derived from the provided remaining term.
- Fixed a bug where running termination journal entries for reversed terminations would incorrectly show an error banner.
- Fixed an issue where the suitelet would fail to load due to an overloaded URL when processing high-volume Map/Reduce jobs.
- Fixed an issue on the Time Machine processing where the allow closed period parameter was not being passed to the Map/Reduce script.
- Fixed an issue on the Time Machine processing where the new NetLessor Fees were not being deleted when deleting the lease.
- Fixed custom sourcing when using the Suitelet or Map/Reduce to create leases from automation rules.
